Approval of Old Minutes:

Cindy motioned to approve; Michael Ko seconded; all in favor; minutes approved

Old Business:

- Our Pros would like to be sponsored by Dunlop; Dunlop will sponsor our pros if we buy the balls from them
 - o Kevin: few other clubs already moved
 - o Chauntelle: Bellevue Club and Country Club already partially moved over
 - o Cheaper balls, better service
- By-laws:
 - Waiting on Bryan to finalize
 - o New liability language in place for members to sign
 - o Cindy: Do we need to have liability/waiver language for guests to sign?
 - Chauntelle: fair bit of grey, best bet to have our insurance buttoned up, need to talk to lawyer

Monthly Business:

- 1. Membership Changes: None
 - Summer Memberships Remaining for Sale: +70% returning members, Just under 40 left, not desperate yet as the pool needs to be readied, we can push remaining sales once we feel like we're closer to opening
- 2. Opening/Closing Participants: None scheduled currently, considering one for June
- 3. Recent & Upcoming Club Events:
 - CPR/First Aid/AED Training: Entire staff CPR current by end-June
 - Cinco de Mayo Social: May 5th, Anthony running it
 - Summer Membership/Pool Opens: May 20th
 - i. Crew working hard on completing pool renovation
 - ii. After crew completes, need 3 days to fill the pool, 3 to heat, 2 for water to sit
 - iii. We have a week's buffer, so it's going to go down to the wire
- 4. Monthly Financials
 - Down \$5k excluding summer membership
 - Going to see a lot of capital expenses showing up in financials this year, e.g., \$35k this month on pool
 - Expect to see positive impact on financials from Anthony joining the Tennis Pros staff
 - Kevin Motioned to approve; Michael seconded, all in favor

Current/New Business:

1. Pool Work Update: -- see above --

- 2. Tennis Staffing Update:
 - Anthony is integrating; early impressions are positive
- 3. Aquatics Staffing Update:
 - Lifeguards/Instructors Needed
 - Have 9 lifeguards, need to get to 18
 - Probably have enough swim coaches
- 4. Tree Inventory/Removal: Bid for \$13k
 - Tree assessment done for \$3.5k
 - Received a plan that had Priority 1, 2, and 3 items with identified trees (140 in all), the work that needs to be done, frequency of review of certain trees, etc.
 - 13 trees to be removed in the next 3-5 years; 3 to be removed as priority 1. The plan also serves city needs for permitting/approval; we will be responsible if we don't remove them and they cause damage.
 - i. Chauntelle: Need approval to spend \$13k to remove 3 trees. It's in the ballpark of what we've spent in the past
 - ii. Cindy motioned to approve, Luisa seconded, all in favor
 - 20 trees that need to be pruned.
- 5. Flights/Upcoming Tennis Committee Meeting Date
 - Heavy sub'ing in March/April 183
 - Not being able to find a sub is creating issues
 - Next meeting in June
- 6. Tennis Court Lighting/Ceiling:
 - Silicone roof covering set to be done in June
 - Group working on Newport High School has engaged. Trying to figure out how to get a lift in to the building to do the ceiling covering
 - Ceiling on court #4 likely to be done in August; Lighting will follow
