Old Business:

Monthly Business:

- 1. <u>Membership Changes</u>: Cindy motioned to approve; Kevin seconded; All in favor; Membership change approved.
 - <u>TBA</u> (Chauntelle to fill in on 1-18): 1 new member -Aki single player...member that left was only a member for 3 months
- 2. Opening/Closing Participants: Next Session in February..lots of interest
- 3. Recent & Upcoming Club Events:
 - Ugly Sweater Social: December 17: 30 people attended; Alex & Corey ran it
 - NYE Party: December 31: 45 attended, no staff: Edna and Tammy host and got good feedback
 - Lunar New Year Party: January 28th (sponsored by Phoenix Insurance)
 - Club Mixed Doubles Championships: February 10-12: signups will happen via USTA websitewill be live by end of week; something will be sent out
 - 2 more events likely around St Patty's day and Cinco de Mayo
- 4. <u>Club Financials and Annual Budget</u> (Kevin): Cindy motioned to approve financials; Ranjit seconded; All in favor; Financials approved.
 - Significant budget changes: closing the pool for 2 months to do the tiling...big costs are staffcost of living wage increases, min wage cost going up
 - Extra pro is not budgeted in...biggest thing to improve income is to hire a 3rd pro!
 - Expecting to make around \$130k in 2023.
 - Wages to instructors are increasing via the lesson rate...EB has a different rate structure from other clubs....increases will be based upon how much they work: increased lesson cost and increased lesson allocated %. CJ thinks we're competitive based on our structure (haven't done any increase in rates since 2019).
 - Kevin is not proposing an increase in dues this year.
 - Everyone is hiring! Raised summer membership costs and Jr initiation fee
 - Chauntelle is going to do a new member 101 education- that they own the club etc.
 - Have about \$800k in bank account; expect \$120k for 2023; In 2023, going to spend a large amount on tennis court improvements and pool fixes. Good rule of thumb is to keep 6 months of expenses (~\$450k). Pool fixes committed to in March and April; Tennis improvements are going to be done over the summer when courts are least used. Tennis improvements can be done within 1 week-probably in Aug when impact is minimal.
 - Kevin motioned to approve the budget; Michael seconded; All in favor; Budget approved.

Current/New Business:

- 1. Flights Survey: will send out in the next couple of days...hopefully will resolve conflict..survey will stay open until the day after annual meeting...the tennis committee will handle
- 2. Virtual Annual Meeting: have to have 25 equity memberships in attendance..everyone reach out to 2-3 members!
- 3. Business from the Floor
 - A viewing chair has broken with someone in it therefore they have all been removed and are going to be replaced.
 - Bellevue Club is hosting a Mercedes Benz electric car event and needs just 16 parking spots over mid-winter break; will park cars on back end of lot and will have staff 24 hours with cars(will be cleaning) It's an opportunity to make some \$\$s.
